

Great River Soy Processing, LLC
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Facility Data Sheet

- Site is 14 acres at north edge of Lilbourn on State Highway “U”
- Site is about 8 miles from I-55
- The facility (building, tank farm, driveways & parking area) takes up about half the land area.
- Site has a rail line at west boundary, but no service spur
- Building is 100 x 120 with a 20 x 30 office space stub out
- Plant equipment production capacity is 5 million gallons per year of B100 biodiesel
- The building has space for adding another production unit to double or maybe triple the production capacity
- The production equipment is manufactured by Greenline
- The production equipment is designed to use soy oil or other vegetable oil as feedstock. Liquefied poultry fat can also be used as part of the feedstock blend.
- All product in and out of the plant is by truck
- Construction was completed in September 2007
- The plant was run for two weeks in Oct 2007 and made 94,000 gal of biodiesel

- GRSP is registered and eligible for the MO Incentive Pay Program (new owner may or may not qualify). The MO Dept of Agriculture can provide details of the program.
- GRSP has completed all filings and registration with the IRS and EPA for fuel production and sales.
- EPA CDX reports have been filed for 2007 Q4 and 2008 Q1.
- GRSP has a MO DNR storm water permit. The DMR’s for 2007 Q4 and 2008 Q1 have been filed.
- GRSP has filed all necessary MO DNR air quality permit documents. Some of the permit process cannot be completed until the plant is running.

- GRSP is not setup to do blending or splash blending on site. This can be added.
- Site has SEMO electric service
- Site has city sewer and water service
- Asking Price is \$6.5 Million
